Qualification

Outline:

Candidates must complete all mandatory units plus one optional unit.

Mandatory Units

All 6 units must be achieved from this group:

- · Investigate and evaluate health and safety incidents and complaints in the workplace
- Ensure responsibility for actions to reduce risks to health and safety
- Develop procedures to safely control work operations
- Monitor procedures to safely control work operations
- Promote a culture of health and safety in the workplace
- · Conduct a health and safety risk assessment of the workplace

Optional Units

A minimum of I unit must be achieved from this group:

- · Make sure actions in the workplace aim to protect the environment
- Review health and safety procedures in the workplace
- Supervise the health, safety, and welfare of a learner in the workplace

Method of assessment

The method of assessment is a **one-step** journey:

Step 1: Portfolio of Evidence

Completing an NVQ doesn't require you to take traditional exams. Instead, assessment is based around your competency in fulfilling your job role duties to meet occupational standards. Assessors will evaluate you based on the contents of your portfolio. It's essential to maintain this portfolio with evidence showcasing the tasks, duties, and accomplishments you've accomplished in work.
